## The Los Gatos High School Community Aquatic Center

All Swim Programs are held at the Los Gatos High School Community Aquatics Center. All lessons are Monday-Friday in two-week sessions, 10 lessons, 30 minutes in length. YOU MAY ENROLL IN ONLY ONE SESSION AT A TIME. THIS WILL HELP REDUCE THE NUMBER OF TRANSFERS NEEDED AT THE START OF EACH SESSION AND THE UNCERTAINTY OF KNOWING IF YOUR CHILD IS READY FOR THE NEXT LEVEL. **On the last two days (Thurs. & Fri.) of each two week sequence of classes, registration of the next session will take place at the LGHS Community Aquatic Center from 9:45 AM-12:45 PM and 4:00 PM-6:45 PM. No registration will be taken at the LGS Recreation office on these last two days of the session.** Once a session has started only the Aquatic Supervisor may accept new registrations. This may be done at the LGHS Community Aquatic Center. Classes not meeting minimum enrollments will be cancelled or combined with another class.

<b>Cuttle Fish:</b> Parent/Child (Max. 8 students per class with one instructor)				
<b>Guppy:</b> Level 1 Introduction to Water Skills (Max. 4 students per class with one instructor)				
<b>Starfish:</b> Level 2 Fundamental Aquatic Skills (Max. 4 students per class with one instructor)				
<b>Seahorse:</b> Level 3 Stroke Improvement (Max. 6 students per class with one instructor)				

**CUTTLE FISH:** This program is designed to teach children how to become accustomed to the water through playful interaction and games. Parents learn about aquatic safety for children. This class does **not** teach children to be accomplished swimmers or survive in the water by themselves. **Prerequisites:** Parent participation required. Skills Checklist: Water adjustment (getting wet), exploring the pool, holding positions, front kick, front glide, passing, underwater exploration readiness, bubble blowing, back float, adjusting to water in back position, rolling over, arm movement and exiting water. Children must wear a swim diaper.

**GUPPY: (Ages 3 & up) Prerequisites:** Children MUST be able to take directions from an instructor and be comfortable in the water. **Children will learn:** To float, glide and flutter kick on front/back with support, introduction to front/back alternating arm strokes, blow bubbles, open eyes underwater and retrieve submerged objects, basic water safety including entering and exiting the water, and introduction to wearing and using a lifejacket

**STARFISH: Prerequisites:** Guppy skills. **Children will learn:** Rhythmic bobs (10 times), float without support on front/back, roll over from back to front and from front to back, front/back glide, flutter kick without support on front/back, introduction to front crawl and back crawl, retrieve objects from bottom of shallow water, and use of lifejackets in deep water.

**SEAHORSE: Prerequisites:** Starfish Skills. **Children will learn/work on:** Swimming front crawl and back crawl for 15 yards, swim elementary backstroke for 10 yards, introduction to side breathing and breaststroke kick, tread water for 30 seconds, retrieve submerged objects from bottom of chest-deep water, jump and dive from a kneeling position into deep water, water safety skills including bobbing to safety and an introduction to dolphin kick and reaching assists.

**DOLPHIN: NOTE:** This class is only held in the 25 yards lanes in 7ft of water. **Prerequisites:** Seahorse Skills. **Children will work on:** Swimming front crawl with rotary breathing, back crawl, and elementary backstroke for 25 yards, swim breaststroke and sidestroke for 25 yards, treading water for 1 minute, introduction to flip turns and standing front dive.

**SHARK: Prerequisites:** Dolphin Skills. **Children will work on:** Swimming front crawl with rotary breathing, back crawl and elementary backstroke for 50 yards with flip turns, swim breaststroke and sidestroke for 25 yards, swim underwater for 3 body lengths, tread water for 2 minutes, introduction to butterfly, and long shallow dives.

**WHALE: Prerequisites:** Shark Skills. **Children will work on:** Swimming front crawl with rotary breathing and back crawl for 100 yards, swim elementary backstroke, breaststroke, sidestroke and butterfly for 50 yards, appropriate turns for all strokes, tread water for 5 minutes, introduction to lifesaving skills including approach stroke, feet first surface dive, retrieval of object from deep water, and survival floats (HELP and huddle positions) for 2 minutes.

**PRIVATE LESSON:** Ages: 4 years old- adults. Instruction is geared toward the individual student's ability. Private lessons are offered Monday through Friday for a total of ten (10) 30 minute lessons. It is possible to have more than one private lesson to run at a time, contact our main office or Jessica Revino at Jessica@lgsrecreation.org for more information.

## RECREATION SWIM

**OPEN:** Monday, June 19th - Friday, August 10th.

**FEE:** \$2 - 4yrs and under  
\$4 - 5-15 yrs old  
\$5 - 16+ yrs old

**SWIM LESSON OBSERVATION:** We allow all parents to observe swim lessons within the pool area with the understanding that you will not interfere with the ongoing lesson. If this becomes a problem, the Pool Manager or Aquatics Supervisor has the right to ask you to observe the lessons from another part of the deck or facility. **Parental interaction from the deck with students should be kept at a minimum as this is distracting to both the student and the instructor.** If your child experiences separation anxiety, may be asked to remain out of sight for the first few lessons (we have several areas where you can view lessons out of sight of your swimmer). Once the child is adjusted into the class, you may return to view in the pool deck area. If a student needs to be excused for any reason during a session, the parent is responsible for escorting the child from the pool.

**HOLIDAYS:** We will be closed July 4th. Session fees have been prorated accordingly.

**CANCELLATIONS: A \$25 processing fee applies to all cancellations. NO refunds will be given after the second class of the session without a doctor's note.** If a doctor's note is provided, a refund for the prorated amount of the session fee (from the date the request was submitted) will be issued. If LGS Recreation cancels a class or session, a full refund will be issued.

**TRANSFERS:** Transfers may be available if space allows but is not guaranteed. No transfers will be permitted after the second class.

**MISSED CLASSES:** If you miss a class we cannot issue refunds, credits or schedule make-up classes. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** We have found that adding students to classes for make-ups disrupts the rhythm of the class. Please do your best to attend your scheduled class time. In the event of a temporary facility closure a credit will be issued equal to the value of the cancelled class.

We reserve the right to cancel any class with fewer than the required minimum prior to the start of the scheduled session.

As a courtesy to all participants, students who arrive more than 10 minutes after the start of the class will be unable to join the class. Teacher requests will be accepted but are not guaranteed.
