## General Information

LGS Recreation's Summer Enrichment School is back with new class offerings and the ones participants already love! Our program, designed and facilitated by credentialed teachers from local school districts, provides young people

the opportunity to keep learning during summer months through a wide-range of challenging, engaging, and fun classes!

**PROGRAM DATES:** June 19th - July 14th (No program July 4th)

**CLASSROOM ASSIGNMENTS:** A Welcome Packet containing classroom assignments will be emailed out to participants and made available online at lgsrecreation.org on June 12th.

**ONLINE REGISTRATION PERIOD:** March 8th – June 7th

**WHO CAN ATTEND:** Any student entering grades K-8th in Fall 2017.

**ENRICHMENT SUMMER SCHOOL CLASS TRANSFERS:** There is a \$20 transfer fee per class after registration has been submitted. From March 8th – June 7th all class transfers can only be processed over the phone by contacting LGS Recreation's Main Office at (408) 354-8700 permitting space.

Transfers will then be made available again-pending class availability, on campus in the Summer Enrichment School Office starting June 21st at 8:00 a.m.

**REFUND REQUEST:** All refund requests can be made by contacting LGS Recreation Main Office at 408-354-8700.

**Refund requests for Before School Care, Summer Enrichment School and After School Day Camp must be made by June 7th at 5:00 p.m. No refunds will be issued after this date.**

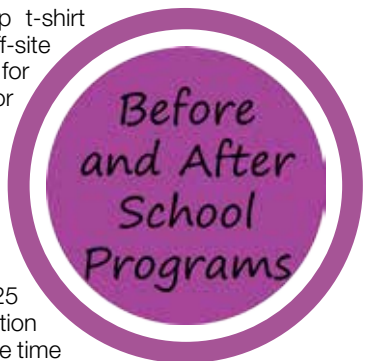

**CAMP T-SHIRT:** This year's camp t-shirt must be worn by students on all off-site field trips. T-shirts can be purchased for \$12 at the time of online registration or also on-site the first week of camp.

## Before and After School Programs

## Before School Care Programs K-8th

The Summer Enrichment School bell rings at 8:20 a.m. or 8:30 a.m. depending on the location, but starting at 7:00 a.m. each location offers Before School Care for parents/guardians that start their work day earlier or have a commute. As students arrive they will have the opportunity to socialize with friends and participate in low impact activities supervised by our staff.

## After School Day Camp Programs K-8th

Once the school bell rings for dismissal the fun doesn't have to stop! We offer After School Day Camp until 6:00 p.m. to all students participating in Summer Enrichment School for an additional fee of \$586 for the entire four weeks. Camp features: arts & crafts, healthy cooking projects, sports & games, swimming (when available), special guest visitors, and a weekly field trip! Staff to camper ratio: 1 to 12. **No After School Day Camp on July 4th.**

**WEEKLY CALENDAR:** A weekly calendar will be emailed out to all participants the Friday before each week of camp detailing all the fun students can expect to have-including field trip information and what to bring each day.

### SUMMER SCHOOL CLASS DESCRIPTIONS ARE IN ALPHABETICAL ORDER & VARY PER LOCATION



**3D Art:** Are you ready to use your hands to make some wonderful 3-D objects? From clay modeling, beading, paper mache, creative structures, to some things ooey goeey, we will be putting a spin on traditional art! This class is one of our most popular, so be sure to sign up now before it fills!

**Drama, Drama, Drama!:** Lights, camera, action! This class offers you the opportunity to make characters come to life through scripts, movement and imagination. Students in this class will have the chance to learn basic acting skills while playing drama games, reading scripts, using simple props and costumes. Practice different strategies to use expression when reading and acting in character. Perform individually, with a partner and as a class. Build your self-confidence and public speaking skills in a fun and safe setting. Come out and play!

**Famous Artists:** Do you love art? Learn about the creative styling of famous artists throughout time. We will study their background, famous works, techniques, and create our own inspired and adapted pieces. You will get to use chalks, oil pastels, paints, inks, and more! Walk away with amazing art projects that will impress your family and friends!

**Garden Critters:** What can be more interesting than bugs? Be a naturalist and explore snails, roly-polies, lady bugs, lifecycles and much more. You will experience live critters and keep a journal of your findings. Bring your curiosity and observations skills to learn more about the garden and the world around you

**Hands On Science:** Explore the world of science in this hands-on class! Students will explore laws of gravity, motion, and magnetism. Build shaving cream towers and calculate gravity. Study Knex Ferris wheels and discover centripetal acceleration! Experience excavation and Paleontology by digging for fossils! Learn about chemical reaction in explosive ways. Join the adventure and learn about scientific investigation, biology, chemistry, physics, engineering, math and archaeology. Challenging and exciting experiments await you!

**Hip-Hop Movement and More:** Want to get moving and grooving? You can shake, rattle and roll in this dance class that will teach basic dance moves. Don't be a wallflower, come out and play so you can learn the latest moves and be a star on the dance floor!

**Kids Can Cook:** A hands-on class for kids whom like to cook and eat. Have fun and learn some new healthy recipes to share with your family and friends. Even the pickiest of eaters will usually try food they prepare themselves. Work on your math and reading skills while measuring and following a recipe. The class will run a store and donate the proceeds to a local charity.

**Math Fun!:** Have fun and build your mathematical confidence! This is a hands-on, center orientated, math game class that will get your mind racing! Use basic math skills and problem solving to improve mathematical reasoning. Use your knowledge to find the answers to math puzzles, brainteasers, and to solve problems. Have fun working individually and in small groups on math challenges and math games to give your brain a work out!

**Speak Up!:** A very popular class! Do you like speaking in front of others, or do you get a bit nervous? Whatever your comfort level with public speaking is, this class is for you! Sign up and experience telling jokes, stories and more that will make speaking in front of others fun and exciting. Learn how to project your voice, build your confidence and speak confidently in front of others.

**Tech Adventures and More:** Using technology, expand your creativity and fine-tune your problem solving skills, all while collaborating with classmates to create a variety of digital presentations. Explore with Nearpod, Kahoot!, and more. Come have fun and create digital memories that you can share with friends and family.

## Course Descriptions 4th-5th Grade
