PROGRAM HALF & FULL DAY CAMPS

Summer recreation programs are offered in Full Day, AM Half Day, and PM Half Day and One Day options. Lunchtime supervision is not guaranteed between individual AM and PM programs. We may, however, coordinate care if requested by 2 or more students and as available. Once you've identified your desired camps, please contact the LGS Recreation office at 408.354.8700 and they will direct you to the appropriate Program Coordinator.

DROP-OFF & PICK-UP AREA

When dropping off or picking up your camper at the school or camp location, please use the designated drop-off and pick-up areas. Please abide by posted signs, crosswalks and the directions to ensure the safety of all children. Please adhere to applicable guidelines and signage as provided and available onsite.

CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT

All parents/guardians are asked to check in and check out your camper each day. Please make sure you speak directly with an instructor and adhere to guidelines and signage as provided onsite.

ABSENTEEISM

There is no mandatory requirement to attend camp each day, but we hope your camper will be excited to attend! If you are inclined to report that your child will not attend the day of, please contact the Recreation Office at 408.354.8700 and we will relay the message to the appropriate instructor. Refund requests, due to participant absence for medical or family reasons, will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis.

REFUND POLICY

Refunds and transfers are permitted up to 5 business days before the start of a camp/program unless otherwise stated. The Refund Fee is \$10 for classes up to \$100, \$25 for classes over \$100. Transfer Fee is \$10 per participant, per program. Please contact the LGS Recreation Office for assistance as needed.

SNACK & WATER & SUN SCREEN

Please send your child to camp with bottled water and a light snack for half day camps and lunch for full day camps. Please refrain from sending any snacks containing peanuts.

CLASSROOM & CAMPUS RULES

Students are expected to keep the campus clean, put litter in cans, and only eat in designated areas. Glass beverages, gum and sunflower seeds are not allowed on campus.

WHAT TO WEAR

We encourage students to wear appropriate casual clothing and comfortable shoes to the program, daily-tennis shoes are highly recommended for students enrolled in physical activities. Please have your child wear/bring sunscreen daily if they are enrolled in outdoor programs.

CELL PHONES & ELECTRONICS

Students are permitted to bring cell phones to camps, provided that the phone is put away during camp time. We ask that all other electronic devices or personal valuables be left at home, as they can be a disruption in camp and LGS Recreation cannot be responsible for these items.

TECHNOLOGY AGREEMENT

Many programs utilize specialty equipment and technology. We ask students to exercise caution and care.

DRUG FREE CAMPUS

All program locations are a "Drug Free" environment. The use of any illicit drug or tobacco product is prohibited on campus. Students who bring any illicit drug, tobacco product or lighters to school will be suspended and/or dismissed from the program.

GENERAL CODE OF CONDUCT

LGS Recreation is committed to providing a safe and welcoming environment for participants, visitors, and staff. Individuals are expected to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner at all times and adhere to all program, District, Local, State, and Federal Laws, Regulations, and/or local ordinances with regard to behavior. Failure to comply may result in losing the temporary or permanent privilege of using LGS facilities and/or participating in programs. LGS Recreation reserves the right to refuse service to anyone for any reason that does not violate federal, state, or local discrimination laws.

STUDENT BEHAVIOR

Students are expected to demonstrate good character while participating in the program and adhere to the general Code of Conduct.

- Treat others with respect
- Be honest
- Follow camp instruction
- Be kind
- Play by the rules

Any student who disrupts the program experience for others may be removed from the program by the Instructor/Program Operator or LGS Recreation without receiving a refund.

INSTRUCTOR SUPERVISION STANDARDS

Instructors are responsible for the supervision of participants during the entire duration of camp. No student may leave camp at any time without being released to the parent/guardian or without receiving written permission to walk/bike home in advance of the program.

Bathroom breaks will be supervised or with a buddy 2-3 at a time (only when restrooms are near the classroom). Otherwise, programs will take bathroom breaks with the instructor escorting the full group. When supervised, instructors will stand in the doorway of the restroom. Instructors will ensure all students maintain cleanliness and proper behavior in restroom facilities.

Information that identifies or relates to our participants will be considered confidential. Student contact information is not to be distributed and is for the use of instructor only as it relates to the camp. Instructors shall not be in personal contact with participating children outside of the program for any reason.

SAFETY/FIRST AID

The instructor will ensure the safety of participants and will have a First Aid Kit on hand always. In the event an accident or injury occurs during a program, the parent/guardian on file and/or emergency contact will be contacted. Please ensure your LGS Recreation student profile is fully complete and current.
